Dear Professor Ferrater:

The address of Dr. George L. Kline, which you asked for in your letter of May 5th is as follows:

I take the opportunity to ask you for an item of information which possibly you may be able to supply in connection with the bibliographical section of the Journal. This concerns a book or monograph byLidia Peradotto, entitled "La logistica," and published in 1925. I have seen a reference to this in Diccionario de filosofía (1944), as well as in one or two other places. I want information about the work principally for the sake of the completeness of our bibliographical section, as we make every possible effort to see that everything whatever published in our field is listed in the Journal in some manner. I have made already a number of unsuccessful attempts to find this. but would take the opportunity to ask you also about it, just in case you may have the information that I need or some suggestion as to how a copy may be obtained. I need to know in particular the name of the publisher and the place of publication, and the number of pages, in order to complete the bibliographical reference. And I would also like to find out if possible something about the content of the book in order to judge how it should be indexed in the bibliographical indexes in the Journal. I suppose it is not likely that there is anything of importance in this book or monograph, or it would be better known. However, as I said, I would like to find out about it for the sake of completeness of our bibliography and would very much appreciate any help that you can give me with this.
