Dear Professor Ferrater:

Thank you for your letter of November 12th. I would appreciate it very much indeed if you could obtain for me a copy of <u>Kultura</u> containing the Polish translation of your review. I had intended to write to Professor Bochenski asking for information but have not had time; of course it would be still more helpful if I could have a copy of the review itself for reference, and incidentally would save me from troubling Professor Bochenski to supply information.

The manuscript of Volume 1 of my Mathematical Logic is in the hands of the printer, but the actual printing is being delayed while a number of symbols for it are being made on order. I am still hoping that the book will be in print by this Summer (Princeton University Press). Meanwhile the book is available in manuscript form, and can be had from the Fine Hall Library if you need to look at it, by applying to your own librarian and asking to have it sent on inter-library loan. This manuscript copy does not contain quite all the last minute amendments and additions that I made before sending the manuscript to the printer but it is near enough to the final form for most purposes. I should add that the manuscript is bound in separate bound pamphlets, one for each chapter, so that the introduction and five chapters can be obtained one at a time if desired (each for a period of some weeks).
