

My question to you at this moment is whether you would consider to teach a graduate course with us in either fall 59/60 or in spring 60. A course consists of 15 weekly double-hour sessions of 100 minutes each, either 6:20-8:00 or 8:30-10:10 P.M., for which a stipend of \$ 1,000 is offered. But your response in principle to the proposition would be helpful for our planning at this moment.
