The Department of Philosophy here at Bowling Green has been authorized to fill a full professorship beginning next September. It has given a good deal of thought, engaged in an examination of current philosophical literature, and talked to individuals around the country — in order to ascertain the names of likely candidates for its opening. Your name appears high on that list. Incidentally Francis Parker, at Purdue, first suggested you to us.
