
REPORT:

Professor Ramon Xirau has done very distinguished work in the field of his choice --the relation between philosophic thought and literature, particularly poetry--. Being himself a poet, as well as a philosopher, he has been able to probe into this subject both from a creative and from a scholarly point of view.

It should be pointed out that Professor Xirau is at present at the peak of his scholarly and literary career. Interesting and challenging as his work has been in the past --in particular in the last ten years--, his most creative undertakings lie, in my opinion, in the future.

Professor Xirau is specially endowed to carry on the project he has outlined. He has a profound sense of religious experience, which he links with poetic experience. He has already worked on the contemporary philosophers he plans to investigate further, and it is to be expected that he will cast on them a novel point of view.
