Dear Professor Ferrater Mora:

A considerable amount of interest has been expressed here in the possibility of inviting you to Penn State for a week's involvement in the workings of the departments of Philosophy and of Spanish, Italian, and Portuguese. During the proposed visit we would ask you to give two lectures, one in philosophy and one in Spanish literature.
