Dear Mr. Ferrater Mora,

Thank you very much for the address and for the stationery. I've now ordered the books, and I hope I have the titles right, but I'm none too sure about it. The editor is not, as I told you, Geneviève Rodis-Lewis, but rather Ginette Dreyfus.

The difficulty about the titles is this. The volume which I mentioned to you is a critical commentary on the first edition of the Traité de la nature et de la grâce, together with a printing of that first edition alone. This book is labelled "volume II". But I can find no clear reference to what volume I is. Mlle. Dreyfus did, however, edit the collated edition of the Traité which is volume V of the Oeuvres complètes. That volume was published in 1958, as was the commentary on the first edition, both by J. Vrin. Consequently, I assume that volume V of the Oeuvres complètes must be the volume I in question.

Apparently it does not follow that volume II is a portion of the Oeuvres complètes, even on the assumption that volume I is volume V of the set. I did what I could to check the matter at the Yale library on the way home from Fairfield last week, but finished none the wiser. Well, doubtless it is all very simple to the publisher. I await the arrival of my two volumes to verify what they are!
