3. It is understood that the cost of travel between the student's home and the United States, and return, and of spending money for the year, will be provided as follows:

Student will pay for round-trip travel between his home and the United States, and for spending money.

4. It is clearly understood that this scholarship is for one year only, and that the student will be required to return home at the end of that period.
5. Although the American Field Service would, of course, get in touch with the student's family if any medical emergency should arise, and would ask their permission for any operation or other treatment if time permitted this to be done, it nevertheless needs to be able to take quick action if necessary. The student's parents or guardian therefore hereby agree to authorize the American Field Service to act for them in any emergency of accident or illness.
6. The American Field Service will assume all necessary responsibilities that the student's own parents are too far away to assume. The American Field Service organization will keep in close touch with him while he is in the United States, and he will be expected to keep in close touch with it.
