Dear Prof. Ferrater,

Thank you for undertaking the review of Frucht's paper. I am sending the review copy separately.

Thank you also for calling my attention to Stahl's book. I have already written to him (at Quine's suggestion). – As to further publications about logic in Spanish, I have several papers by J. D. <u>García</u> Bacca that appeared in Acta Científica Venezolana. From superficial examination, one of them at least contains serious errors of a kind that may be difficult to straighten out.

I haven't decided on a reviewer; but as the task of review is likely to be embarrassing I may meet the difficulty by writing the review myself. There is a long paper by Hector Neri <u>Castañeda</u>, not yet examined. And besides my own paper (of which I sent you a copy) there are a number of other papers in Spanish about logic in Memoria del Congreso Científico Mexicano I. Of these the paper by Gonzalo <u>Zubieta</u> Russi seems to me to be of greatest general interest, though it contains nothing very substantially new. (Do not confuse Gonzalo Zubieta with his brother who also contributed a paper to the same volume.) If you have not seen the volume it may be obtained from Princeton on interlibrary loan. Conceivably some of the items may be of interest for the bibliographies in your <u>Diccionario</u>.
