Dear Prof. Ferrater,

Thank you for undertaking the review of Klimovsky's paper. — As to the length of the review, I feel a certain obligation that the review should not be too brief, in view of the fact that we received the complete volume as review copy from the publisher at our request. I should not want to see a review of more than our standard maximum of 500 words, unless more careful examination of the paper should reveal some quite unexpected special reason. As a matter of fact it's possible that Klimovsky's paper may be found to have some originality of viewpoint or emphasis if not of content. But if you find it not profitable to use as much as (say) 250 words in the review of Klimovsky, then perhaps we should consider compensating by publishing at least a brief review of another paper in the same volume. — The paper by Monteiro in this volume, L'arithmétique des filtres et les espaces topologiques, I have at present recorded for listing by title. But it is a border-line case, and I have no objection to your writing a short review of the paper if you wish to do so, whether to compensate for your seeking some one to collaborate with you in the review of the paper if you think it desirable.
