Dear Professor Ferrater Mora:

I enjoyed meeting you and listening to your lecture and informal talk when you came to the University of Kansas several years ago, and I wonder whether you could be prevailed upon to come to Northwestern University for a quarter some time in the future. Both the Spanish and the Philosophy Departments would be delighted if you would do so.

Specifically, Northwestern has a visiting professorship known as the Concora Lectureship which is made possible by a continuing grant from the Container Corporation of America. It has already brought many distinguished scholars and writers here, among them Stephen Spender, Sean O'Faolain, Frank O'Connor, and Hannah Arendt.

The holder of the Concora appointment is a teacher rather than a writer or scholar in residence, but the teaching duties are pleasant. The Concora Lecturer usually offers two different courses in subjects appropriate to his interests, one primarily for graduate students, the other for undergraduates. Your teaching program could, of course, be worked out to the mutual satisfaction of yourself and interested departments. The Spanish Department would like you to offer a course in Spanish. The subject might be Unamuno, Unamuno and Ortega, The Generation of '98, etc. The Philosophy Department would, of course, want you to teach their course in English.

The stipend for a one quarter appointment is currently \$8,000. The quarters are normally ten weeks long, although the fall quarter is often a week longer.

I do hope that this sounds interesting to you.
