Under separate cover we are sending to you volume I of IHE and numbers 9-12 of vol. II. Please sent to us in exchange numbers 1-3 (vol. I) and number 1 (vol. II) of HA.

The exchange between H.A. BULLETIN and ESTUDIOS DE HISTORIA MODERNA will continue.

It is great honour for us to be associated with HISTORICAL ABSTRACTS and we are looking forward to settling down in a near future the second part of our collaboration.
