Dear Professor Ferrater-Mora:

As you may be aware, the Institute of International Education is the agency designated by the Department of State to conduct annual competitions and to make the preliminary selection of candidates for awards for graduate study and research abroad under the Fulbright-Hays Act. To that end, we invite area specialists and authorities in various fields to serve on our National Screening Committee, whose responsibility it is to review applications and to nominate candidates to the Board of Foreign Scholarships. The enclosed brochure describes the part of this exchange program with which we are concerned.

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I take pleasure in asking you to join the Committee which will review candidates for awards to Spain and Portugal during the 1966-67 academic year. The meeting you would be expected to attend is scheduled to take place at the Institute's headquarters, 809 United Nations Plaza, New York City on December 22, 1965 from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. We believe your judgment and knowledge would be of great value in the deliberations of the Committee.

All expenses incurred by you in connection with this assignment will, of course, be reimbursed by the Institute.
