Dear Professor Ferrater-Mora:

Recently I sent a special delivery letter to Dr. Nahm (dated May 31, 1971) concerning my request to be enrolled in the unit of supervised research on the dissertation.

Time is very important right now, since I must receive a letter from Bryn Mawr stating that I am so enrolled before the end of June, or my teaching position for next fall will have to be cancelled for lack of a renewed California teaching credential.

I thought perhaps Dr. Nahm had already left for the summer and so did not receive my letter.
