Following up my telephone call of last evening, on behalf of this Department I should like formally to invite you to give two half courses in Spanish literature in the 1965 Harvard Summer School.

The Summer School classes meet beginning Wednesday, July 7 and continue through Friday, August 20. The following week consists of two days of Reading Period and then three days of final examinations. In other words, the Summer School terminates on Friday, August 27.

I enclose a statement about the Summer School which discusses salary.

The two half courses would be at your own choosing. Both the Director of the Summer School and I would hope that one of them would be in the category "for undergraduates and graduates" and would have rather wide general appeal. The other could be a graduate seminar. We would expect both half courses to be given in Spanish.
