We have written and are ready to post a beautifully (1) structured request on our behalf penned by Marcell Gutdurth. In addition, we are attempting to convince Welliam Davidon to write a physicist friend in Paris (who is a close personal friend of Sartre) to convince his further that his experience at Haverfrod would be a rewarding one. We are also attempting to contact Russell Steller (164) who, in conjunction with Sartre and others, planned the War Crimes Tribunal in Sabchcham.

This is our position to date. Because of the "gravity" of the task at hand, your help in this matter would be most welcome. Do you have any suggestions as to a successful approach?? So far we know the following: he has an incredible ego, and likes to think of himself as a "dirty old man," He has vowed never to come to the W. S. of A. as long as the War is on; he cancelled a speaking engagement at Cornell and forfeited the Nobel Frize & years ago as a two protest. We are able to offer him \$5,000 in Commencement and Phillips Lecture Funds, plus all expenses.
