Dear Mr. Ferrater,

I am in receipt of your letter of February 15, forwarding copies of documents received by you, related to a charge made against you for speeding at Antwerp on 27 June 1965.

If you do not agree with the charges for which you have been sentenced to pay a fine, there is no other possibility than to appeal. In that case, I would advise you to get in touch with a Belgian lawyer.

On the other hand, if you accept the charge, you will have to pay the fine when notified by the Collector of Fines as you understood from the translation of the documents,

Since these documents reached you, I do not see any reason why the subsequent notification would not be seen to the same address.
