Dear Professor Ferrater:

I think back with pleasure upon the week that you spent with our department last year and on the many interesting things you told us. It is also on the strength of our own interesting conversations that I am taking the liberty of writing you this letter.

As you may know, I am one of the editors for the Bollingen Foundation putting out a nine volume Selected Unamuno. The first volume, which I hope you have already received, includes the translation of the Vida de Don Quijote y Sancho and related essays. We are now working on a volume which will include The Tragic Sense of Life, The Agony of Christianity and other essays by Unamuno on the religious theme.

This volume will be prefaced by the 1925 essay by Salvador de Madariaga and needs a preface which will be a more rigorous philosophical analysis of the aforementioned works.

The Board of Editors immediately thought of approaching you on the possibility of writing such an introduction. You could of course, if you wished, write this essay in Spanish which we would then translate or, if you like, you could write it in English. There would of course be a fee for this contribution.

Both the Board of Editors and I would feel great gratification if you could find the time in the next six months or so to do such a preface for this volume and if you indicate your willingness I will then send you a copy of the entire table of contents of the volume being prepared.

May I repeat my personal hope that you will give this suggestion your attention and your acceptance.
