Thank you very much for your kind words on my Diccionario de filosoffa. I have, indeed, tried to balance the Anglo-Saxon, German, and Latin traditions as much as my knowledge permitted. There are, unfortunately, a considerable number of misprints --including Varities instead of Varieties in the bibliography of the article about you-- but I hope that some of the most blatant ones will disappear in forthcoming reprints.

I am pleased to send herewith a Xerox copy of my article "Wittgenstein: A Symbol of Troubled Times," as well as a copy of the same article, "Wittgenstein o la destrucción" in its Spanish (slightly modified) version. I have no copy of the original (1949) Spanish text, but I think that there are no substantial differences in the various versions. The year '1949' may account for the premature and bold character of my interpretation.
