Dear Professor Ferrater Mora,

Prefessor Klibansky, who is at present engaged in fulfilling lecturing engagements outside McGill, asked me to acknowledge letters concerning the Survey which might arrive before his return.

He will be very pleased I knew, that you will undertake to write the section on Ortega for the Survey of Philesophy in Mid-Century.

From the indications that Professor Klibansky gave me, I am able to say definitely that your understanding is correct; while the section should be centred on the later work of Ortega, a general appraisal is welcome. Furthermore, the section need not be confined to publications which appeared before the end of 1955, but may well include those later publications which you consider to be of particular interest. I know too that Professor Klibansky would wish you to refer to your own book - both in the original and in the English versions.

Professor Klibansky was considering the possiblity of adding a picture of Ortega. Would it be possible for you to obtain a good photograph that would be suitable for reproduction?
