by now you must have heard from the counseling center. I discussed Jaime at some length with the relevant person, touching for him, expanding on his problems as I understand them, and trying to find out what they (the Counseling Center) have in mind.

Jaime's education will not be terminated. At the very worst, he will be asked to take off a quarter or even a year, until he sorts himself out - perhaps even takes some correspondence courses. This is the worst that can happen. At best, he will be allowed to get register in the Fall. He has not failed; it is only that he seems to be heading toward failure. The counselors wish to wait a letter from his psychiatrist, indicating that he is well enough to use his chance without damaging his own record. I urge you to ask the psychiatrist to write about Jaime's progress + prospects now - before your return.

My own wife is in very bad shape, I am just off to the doctor with her & may have to admit her to the hospital. I have not heard anything new from Yale Press.
