Dear Professor Mora:

Thank you for your letter of April 17th. In a few days we will send you a complimentary copy of the Malebranche bibliography. Whether the definitive work I planned will be published has become uncertain. Andre Robinet just wrote me to say that v. 20 of his Malebranche edition will contain a complete bibliography, and I shall offer him the use of additional material I have been collecting. If his work has substantial critical annotations, I shall of course abandon my project, though I doubt that it will, considering that this is an official edition.


The Descartes bibliography, as it stands now, will be in two volumes (about 450-500 p.) and cover the period 1800-1957. If this work proves to be sufficiently useful, I shall add a third volume, covering the difficult years 1628-1800, i.e. a bibliography of Cartesianism as a philosophical movement. And this volume may well be extended to include a critical Malebranche bibliography that will supplement Robinet without duplicating it.

The present two Descartes volumes will be out by the end of May and June respectively. They will be priced at \$8.00 to \$10.00, with 70 copies only for sale. If you want a copy for review purposes, I'll be glad to ask that your name be placed on the mailing list for review.

May I take the opportunity and ask you for any corrections, additions, and suggestions for the improvement of either bibliography? Also, would you kindly let me have reprints of any articles relevant to this subject? Your assistance will be much appreciated.
