Thank you very much for the address and for the stationery. I've now ordered the books, and I hope I have the titles right, but I'm nome too sure about it. The editor is not, as I told you, Geneviève Rodis-Lewis, but rather Ginette Dreyfus.

The difficulty about the titles is this. The volume which I mentioned to you is a critical commentary on the first edition of the Traité de la meture et de la grâce, together with a printing of that first edition alone. This book is labelled "volume II". But I can find no clear reference to what volume I is. Mile. Preyrus did, however, edit the collatos dittion of the Traité which is volume V of the Ceuros complètes. That volume was published in 1985, as was the commentary on the first edition, both by J. Vinn. Consequently, I assume that volume V of the Ceuvres complètes must be the volume I in questions.

Apparently it does not follow that volume II is a portion of the Gewirres completes, even on the assumption that volume I is volume V of the set. I did what I could to check the natter at the Vale 1 brary on the way home from Fairfield last week, Judy initiated none the wisers. Well, doubtless it is all very simple to the publisher. I swait the arrival of gry two volumes to verify what they are!
