Ezequiel de Olaso of Philosophy, I am editing a book on "Cultural Relativism Luiz H. Lopes dos Santos and Philosophy". In that round-table there was a very Luiz Roberto Monzani strange "confrontation/cooperation" between Latin American Marcelo Dascal and North American philosophers. On both sides there were, Michel Ghins on the one hand, those who defended a "cultural" relativism Oswaldo Porchat Pereira affecting the themes, the methods, the standards of excellence, and the criteria of assessment of philosophy, Corpo Editorial/ and, on the other, those who argued for the universality of Advisory Editorial Board philosophy (and with it, of "truth", "method", "knowledge", Gérard Lebrun etc.). The former position was held either under the recent Gilles G. Granger impact of critics of "foundationalism" such as Rorty or else Aix-en-Provence in line with earlier "indigenist" conceptions of philosophy, Hector N. Castañeda especially in Latin America. The latter, by defenders of the Bloomington methods of analytic as well as 'traditional' philosophy. The Hugh M. Lacey
Swarthmore purpose of the book is to allow for a more thorough Jaakko Hintikka discussion of these issues, especially regarding the Helsinki/Tallahassee connections between North American and Latin American John R. Searle philosophy.
