
Dear Professor Ferrater Mora:

Thank you very much for your letter of May 30. I hope that Professor Caputo explained to you that we would have liked to publish his beautiful essay earlier but that we have made prior commitments to publish four articles on Heidegger written by Professors Levinas, Pöggeler, Biemel, and Birault. However, if there should be a chance to include Caputo's essay in the last issue of the current volume we shall certainly try to do so.

The second point you mention in your letter is more complicated. We would like to give all contributors some reprints of their articles, but feel that we cannot afford to do so as long as we have to work with funds from foundations. Within a few years we will be able, I hope, to materialize this ideal which we have had from the very beginning in that we firmly believe that an author has the right of receiving at least some reprints of his own work. I hope that you will understand our position here. Finally, I shall communicate our view to Professor Muguerza, also, and tell him that I shall present his suggestion to Professors Anderson and Schrag.
